


# GOOGLE CLASSROOM TEMPLATE TUTORIAL

Adding Federal Reserve Education resources is as easy as 1, 2, 3.



**1.**

After ensuring you are signed in to your Google profile, click the Google Classroom button on the resource landing page. Make sure you're signed in to your google profile.




Select the blue "Use Template" button. Note that by using the template, this resource is now saved onto your google drive account. The entire assignment, including the form and student responses, will all live on your drive as a copy you have total control over.



In a Google Classroom you've created, select "Classwork" and then click the blue "+ Create" button. Select the first option, "Assignment" then to add the Google Form.



Click on the "Drive" icon, find the template form you just saved and add it to the assignment. Be sure to give your new assignment a title.



**3.** Finish by adding your own instructions, customizing the grading scale, including due dates, etc. Then, be sure you hit the blue "Assign" button to make it visible to your students!
