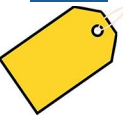


FREF Elementary School Curriculum

Economic Concept	Lesson Plan Summary
<u>Scarcity</u> 	Take the first step in introducing scarcity with <i>Four Feet, Two Sandals</i> , in this active learning lesson.
<u>Economic careers</u> 	Explore what types of career opportunities are available for students who study economics .
<u>Circular Flow</u> 	Take a trip with your students to see how resource and product markets work together to benefit people who make and buy goods .
<u>Prices</u> 	Shop around for the best lesson that introduces how consumers' behavior is changed by prices .
<u>Money</u> 	Cash in with this lesson on the characteristics and functions of money .
<u>Banking</u> 	Examine the important role banks play in a community by providing loans to individuals and businesses.
<u>Public Goods</u> 	Build a community with your students to introduce how governments provide certain goods and services through taxes .
<u>Demand</u> 	Quench your students' thirst for knowledge by having them react to changes in price of their favorite beverages and how that helps explain the law of demand .
<u>Trade</u> 	Tie together the relationship between consumers and countries, and explore how trade can be beneficial.
<u>Human Capital</u> 	Put your students to work on how building human capital through education and other tools can affect income-earning potential.
