5.) Fruity Food Pellets sell for \$.50 an ounce, or \$6.00 a pound. Which is the better buy?

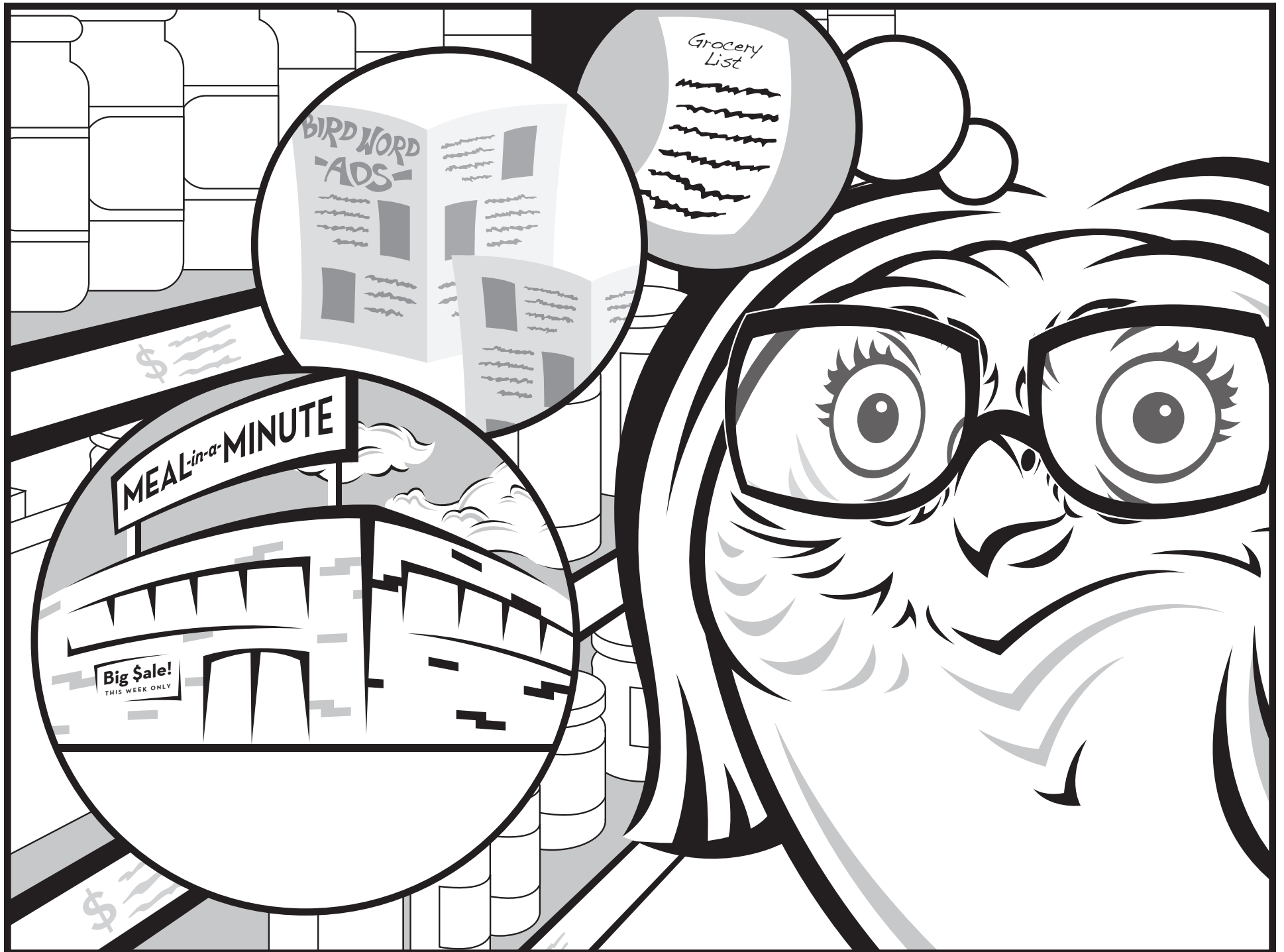




Rhoda Roadrunner dashed down the aisle of the Frequent Flyer Market. She crashed into Olivia Owl, and Olivia and her food flew into the air.
